In 1974, legislation recognized alcoholism and drug addiction as illnesses and provided an alternative to disciplinary action.

Most states belong to the FSPHP. The purpose of the FSPHP is to aid in the education and exchange of information among state programs, develop common objectives and goals, to develop standards, and enhance awareness of issues relating to physician and provider health and impairment. Each state has its own regulations and legislation that mandates their wellness programs and the FSPHP is the umbrella that coordinates the information or "best practices" to help each state succeed.
